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Annie's Lane Moscato 2014

In the early days of winemaking in the Clare Valley the local community would often help each other during the busy times of the season. After delivering lunches to workers pruning vines in the middle of winter one year, Annie Wayman's horse-drawn cart struck difficulty in negotiating the muddy track back to her cottage. From that day on, the track has been affectionately known as Annie's Lane, and today borders one of our major vineyards in the Clare Valley.

Blushed salmon pink colour in the glass, this 2014 Moscato shows vibrant musk aromatics with lifted tropical fruit. The palate displays fleshy Turkish delight, rose petals and quince flavours, finishing with natural fruit sweetness balanced by crisp acidity and zest.

This 2014 Annie's Lane Moscato is a fun and frivolous wine style that is a joy by itself, or accompanied with your favourite dessert. Light in alcohol and slightly spritzed; this is a versatile wine to suit all occasions.

Winemaking

The 2014 Moscato is made from Red Frontignac. This wine was fermented in stainless steel and bottled early to retain a fresh fruit focus.

Cellaring
